Sinus Exposure After-Care

Your sinus cavity has been exposed following a surgical procedure. The sinus should heal without complications if you can help by following these instructions:

- Take prescribed antibiotics as directed, these are essential to prevent infection
- Use all medications as directed on your prescriptions
- Refrain from vigorous mouth rinsing
- Do not smoke
- Do not blow your nose; wiping or blotting with a tissue is acceptable if necessary. Some discharge may be expected for the first few days, this discharge can contain blood
- Do not suppress a sneeze. If you must sneeze, open mouth widely during sneeze to avoid pressure in the nasal and sinus area. Heavy pressure with a finger against the upper lip will sometimes break the sneeze reflex.
- Do not engage in water sports
- Try not to travel by air within the first 72 hours after sinus surgery

Strict adherence to these instructions may prevent the necessity of surgical closure at later date.
